Directions to the show: FROM THE NORTH, Hwy. 101 south to Paso Robles, exit on 24th St. and turn left (turns into Hwy. 46), the second light after the freeway is Golden Hills, turn right. Go to Creston Rd. and turn left. Go approx. 8-10 miles, the ranch will be on the right (on the left will be a beautiful racing barn with a racetrack next to the road). FROM THE SOUTH, Hwy. 101 north to Paso Robles, exit at Spring St., at the first light make a right onto Niblick, cross the bridge and continue a couple of miles to Creston Rd., turn right and go approx. 6-8 miles, the ranch will be on the right. FROM THE EAST, take Hwy. 41 or 46 west toward Paso Robles. Almost to Paso, turn left at the light at Golden Hills. Follow the directions above.

Agreement & Release – Signatures Required

Owner/agent/participant agrees that show management is merely providing stabling for the convenience of the participant and that management, the sponsoring organizations and the facility shall have no responsibility whatsoever for any injury, loss, damage, etc., as a result of using said stabling. Owner/agent/participant agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold all sponsoring and recognizing organizations, show management, their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers harmless from any loss, damage or claims as a result of said use. Owner/agent/participant assumes all care, custody, and control with regard to this use. Owner/agent/participant agrees that every horse entered or which they bring to the show grounds will be subject to the rules of the horse show management but that neither the horse show management nor any sponsoring organization will, in any case, be responsible for damages as a result of any loss, damage or claim that may occur. They agree to defend, indemnify and hold the horse show management, their directors, officers, officials and/or volunteers and affiliated organizations harmless there from.

US Equestrian Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a USEF ("the Federation") recognized Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, or Handler and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Constitution and Rules of the Federation and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See Art. 1502.5.

US Equestrian Federation Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition, "ROLLING IN THE CLOVER" SCHOOLING SHOW, to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.

I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including Articles 318 and 1712, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf.

I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, and officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations.
