

Proposal for the Ann Boyce Grant Fund for San Luis Obispo Chapter 1/13/04

The purpose of this grant fund is to financially assist chapter members wishing to attend a special event or activity that is educational in nature and not already sponsored by the SLO Chapter of CDS.

Proposed Criteria for this fund:

1. The grant is open to all chapter members.
2. The applicant should submit the application via first class mail to the SLO Chapter Chair, with the appropriate documentation regarding the class or activity.
3. The grantee will write an article for the Chapter newsletter within two months of scheduled activity. In addition, a short presentation to chapter members at a general membership meeting will be made within 6 months of the activity.
4. Members will be limited to one grant per year.
5. The maximum grant will be \$250 to be awarded bi-annually. The two deadlines for submission are March 1st and September 1st. The recipient will be notified by mail on or about March 15th and September 15th.
6. Individual donations to this fund can be made at any time.
7. Initial seed money for this fund, in the amount of \$1000, will come by transfer from the chapter checking account to an interest bearing savings account. Future funds will come by transferring up to 25% of the profit realized from each chapter activity. The actual dollar amount will be determined by the current chapter board within 30 days of a profitable event.
8. The applications for this fund will be available at each general membership meeting and on request by contacting the SLO Chapter Chair in writing via first class mail or by telephone or by email.
9. A scholarship committee of three chapter members will process the applications. The recipient will be drawn at random from all qualified applicants.
