- SHOW MANAGEMENT reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide classes, or to change officials as it deems necessary. The decision of the show management on all guestions not covered by these rules or the US Eques. Federation Rulebook is final.
- ENTRIES CLOSE ON JUNE 5, 2023. Entries RECEIVED later will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee. Correct fees and copies of Cards MUST ACCOMPANY EACH EN-TRY FORM.

Incomplete, incorrect entries or changes after the closing date will be charged a \$35.00 FEE.

- > NO REFUNDS will be made after the closing date without a Vet. certificate. Refunds after closing will be subject to a \$50 processing fee.
- > RETURNED CHECKS: A fee of \$35.00 will be charged for all returned checks.
- 4. CONDITION OF ENTRY: Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Horse Show Management and property owners will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its Directors and Employees, and property owners harmless for any loss or accident to himself, his horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.
- MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold SLO-CDS and the property owners harmless for injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted unless a parent or guardian signs it. The signature of instructors, agents or other unrelated persons will not be acceptable.
- RIDING TIMES: Riding times will be e-mailed to all exhibitors, and posted on www.slocds.org, on the Thursday before the show. If not received by morning of Friday, June 9, call John Rees 805-328-0591 or go to www.slocds.org or www.foxvillage.com.
- 7. COMPETITION ARENA: 20 X 60-meter outdoor sand. WARM-UP ARENA indoor sand
- 8. TESTS: 2023 USEF tests will be used. FEI 2016 Tests. WDAA 2022 Tests.
- 9. AWARDS: Ribbons through 5th place. First place awards to classes with 3 or more entries.

CLASSES 500, 501, 502: MUST ENTER AND COMPLETE ANY DRESSAGE TEST, INTRO and WESTERN INCLUDED.

- 10. GROUNDS:
 - > HAUL-IN FEE of \$40.00/horse/day for parking/tying is to be added to entry fee.
 - > Exhibitors may park cars and trailers in designated areas only.
 - ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ON SHOW GROUNDS
 - Lunging is allowed only in designated areas.
 - No exhibitor will be allowed to ride in the competition arena during the show day except during his or her scheduled ride time.
 - Persons on foot are not allowed in the warm-up areas.
- 11. STABLING: LIMITED STABLING AVAILABLITY. FIRST ENTRY RECEIVED FIRST SERVED.

By entering this Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Rules of USEF, California Dressage Society and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to release and hold harmless the competition, CDS, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered.

I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, USEF and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition _______ to the following:

I AGREE that CDS and the "Competition" as used herein includes the Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, lessee, owner, agent, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death.

I AGREE to hold harmless and release USEF, CDS and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

CAWDA High Point Fees

We at the California Western Dressage Association realize that participating in horse shows can be expensive. When the board proposed the high point program, our focus was to keep costs down by including schooling shows, open shows and combined events shows. The CAWDA requires show organizations participating in the CAWDA High Point Shows to remit \$3 per western dressage entry to the CAWDA. The \$3 fee is identified on the show program as the CAWDA High Point fee. This fee is used to offset the cost of the high point program. There are no other fees paid to the CAWDA, nor does the CAWDA request any other fees from shows

or participants for the high point program.

CAWDA does not require or collect any per class fee. It does not request show management to identify which classes will qualify for the High Point. CAWDA Members can submit any test from a High Point designated show for inclusion in their high Point score calculation.

The CAWDA is not responsible and has no control over cost of classes, grounds fees or special fees such as "office" or "processing" fees. Any other costs listed on the show premium are at the discretion of show management and are paid to the show management. Any awards or ribbons given by show management are by decision of the show management, and CAWDA has no stake or influence over these.

Regional Adult Amateur Competition

MISSION: The mission of these competitions is to provide an opportunity for all CDS Adult Amateur riders to qualify and compete against others of similar skills and experience. The regional nature of these shows will help to provide our membership with a developmental path for gaining competitive experience, promote excellence and increase awareness of and support for the Chapters. Goals:

#1 – For the Chapters: These regional or "mid" level adult amateur competitions are designed to promote and enhance awareness and participation by the CDS Chapters, provide State level support in funding and advertisement, and a chance to generate funds at the chapter level.

#2 - For the Riders: These competitions will provide a positive "introductory" show experience for some, which will hopefully be a stepping stone to bigger things, while offering the other more experienced amateur riders a warm-up for the Championship Show.

#3 - For the Whole Organization: These competitions are designed to bridge the gap between the local chapter shows with individual year end awards programs and the tremendously difficult, top caliber competition at the Annual CDS Championship Show.

LOCATIONS: Two Regional CDS Chapter Adult Amateur Competitions will be held this year, one in each of the regions as defined in the CDS bylaws; north, central and south. The COMPETITIONS will be:

Southern: July 15-16, Temecula Chapter

Central: August 19-20, Santa Barbara Chapter Northern: August 25-27, Valley Oaks / Star Vaughn Equestrian

- **ELIGIBILITY:** .
- Participants at the RAAC shows must be current members of CDS, must have a USEF • Amateur Card under Dressage Rules, and must be 22 year of age or older.
- The horse owner must be a current member of CDS.
- Qualification is for an amateur rider/horse team.
- To be eligible to compete, the \$25 registration fee for each horse and rider team per • level MUST BE PAID to the CDS Central Office by close of business no later than 12 days prior to the first day of competition at the regional show entered.
- Scores earned before paying the fee will count provided the payment is received at the • Central Office prior to close of business as specified above.
- 2023 Qualifying Opens: August 31, 2022 at any show with CDS recognition.
- 2023 Qualifying Closes: 12 days prior to the first competition day of the regional show entered.
- Scores earned at the CDS Championship Show will NOT count towards qualification. ٠
- Horse/rider teams who qualify MAY compete in ONLY ONE regional competition
- Qualification scores must be earned at CDS recognized shows and are as follows, scores can be earned at any test of the level:
- 3 scores from 2 judges at Introductory C of 65% or higher, USDF Intro C only, Novice only
- 3 scores from 2 judges at Training Level of 60% or higher, any test
- 3 scores from 2 judges at 1st level of 60% or higher, any test
- 3 scores from 2 judges at 2nd level of 60% or higher, any test
- 3 scores from 2 judges at 3rd level of 60% or higher, any test
- 3 scores from 2 judges at 4th level of 60% or higher, any test
- 3 scores from 2 judges at PSG of 60% or higher
- 3 scores from 2 judges at Intermediare 1 of 60% or higher
- Elite horse and rider teams that have won either Champion or Reserve Champion at the CDS Annual Championship Show at Training, and 1st Levels are not eligible to compete in the RAAC shows at that level.
- ROSES Award neck ribbons will be awarded in three divisions for the High Percentage Elite and Novice Rider 50 years of age and older who officially sign-up for the division prior to their RAAC ride. Divisions: Basic through First; Second through Fourth; and FEI.
